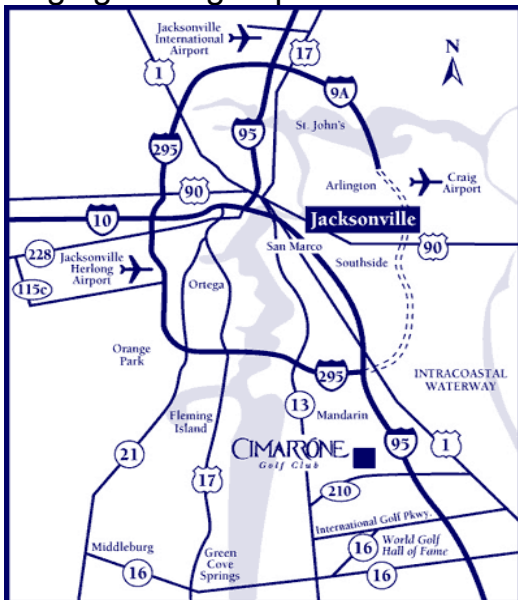
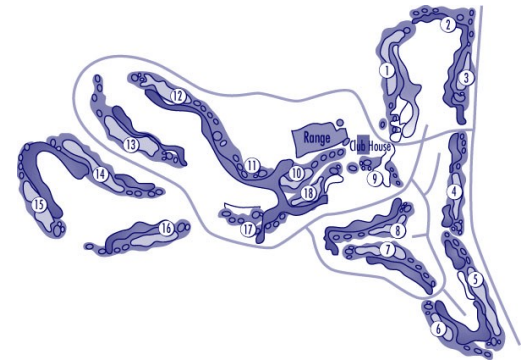

The cost for this years Tournament of \$70.00 (\$10.00 less than last year) includes greens fee, cart, and two mulligans. The Tournament will be a four-person scramble. Each team member hits his or her drive. Each player must have their drive used once each 9 holes. Up to two Mulligan can be used at the golf tournament which will allow you to "cheat". If you have a bad stroke you will be able to hit again without counting the stroke against you. All Golfers, except women, play from white tees or equivalent. The long drives have to be in fairway to count.
