The deadline of April 30, 2011 is approaching for water and wastewater operator license renewals. **This Seminar is not the same as last year and you can receive CEUs for it even if you attended last years session.** Remember that CEUs cannot be awarded until the Administrative fee is received. FRWA cannot accept personal checks or purchase orders as payment. There will be no registration payment taken at the door or taken over the telephone, so get your registration and payment in early!

- FEBRUARY 2, 2010**   **PANAMA CITY, Gulf Coast Community College, 5230 W US Highway 98, 850.872.3818** From the North Take SR 231 to 23rd Street (Look for college directional sign). The college is on the right just before the S Highway 98 intersection. Turn into the college entrance and turn left on College Drive. Parking is on the left. **From the East** Take US Highway 98. The college is located on the north, right before the Hathaway Bridge. **From the West** Take US Highway 98., cross the Hathaway Bridge. The college is on your left just after the bridge. **The seminar will start in the Student Union East Conference Center. - FEBRUARY 3, 2010**   **LAKE CITY, Lake City Community College, 168 SE Student Way, Lake City, 386.752.1822** From North on I-10 East, take exit 301 (US 41 S) towards Lake City, go until you reach 90 West, turn right onto 90 West and continue until you see SE Timberwolf Drive, turn right onto Timberwolf, then after a short distance, turn left unto SE Student Way, PAC will be on the right. From South on I-75 North, take exit 423, turn right onto SR 47 towards Lake City, take SR 47 to Main Ave., on Main Ave., turn right onto Baya Dr., take Baya Dr. to SR 100, turn right, take SR 100 to SE Academic Ave, then turn right on SE Foundation Place, the PAC will be on the left. - FEBRUARY 16, 2010**   **PLANTATION, Volunteer Park Community Center, 12050 West Sunrise Boulevard, 954.452.2558 or 954.452-2559, From Interstate 75:** Take SR 838 (Sunrise Boulevard Exit) and go East approximately 2.25 miles. **From Interstate 595:** Take exit 1B (Flamingo Road exit) merge onto SR 84W, turn right onto 24th Ave (Flamingo Road) and go North approximately 2.5 miles. - FEBRUARY 17, 2010**   **PUNTA GORDA, Charlotte Harbor Event and Conference Center, 75 Taylor Street, 941.833.5443** From North/South on I-75, take exit 164 (US 17-Punta Gorda), turn left (or West, depending how you come) onto US 17 South (West Marion Ave.), after approximately 2 miles, turn right onto Taylor Street, the Event Center is on the left. **From the East,** (West Palm Beach) take US 27N/FL 80 W towards I-75, go approximately 70 miles, merge onto I-75 North, then take exit 164 and follow directions as previously. - MARCH 3, 2010**   **LAKE ALFRED, Citrus Research and Education Foundation, Inc (Ben Hill Citrus Hall), 700 Experiment Station Road, 863.956.1151.** From North on I-75, take the Florida Turnpike towards Orlando, after about 45 miles, take exit 289 towards SR 19/Clermont, after about 4 miles, merge unto US 17S-92W, then make a sharp right onto Experiment Station Road, the facility will be on the right. From West from I-95, take SR 528 W towards Orlando, after about 25 miles, take exit 16 toward SR 417S Orlando/Tampa then exit on left towards Tampa/ Disney World, next merge onto FL 417 S/Central Florida Greenway, after about 14 miles, take I-4 West to exit 55 (US 27 S) towards Haines City, after about 9 miles, merge unto US 17S-92W, continue on to Experiment Station Road and follow directions as above. From East Tampa, take I-4 East about 45 miles, take exit 48 towards Lake Alfred, after 6 miles, turn left onto CR 557, then turn left onto W Haines Blvd to N Lake Shore Way, continue for about 1 mile, make left onto Experiment Station Road follow directions as above. - MARCH 4, 2010**   **LEESBURG, Leesburg Community/Cultural Arts Building, 109 Dixie Ave, 352-728-9850, From the North or South** From US 27 in Leesburg, travel east on 44/Dixie Ave to Dozier Circle, turn right. Dozier is a loop road surrounding the Community Building. **From the East** Take US 441 to Canal St., turn left (south), which goes directly to Venetian Gardens Parking Lot **From the West** Take 44 West to Canal Street, turn right (south). ## FOCUS SESSIONS and CEUs

- This session is not the same as last year, so you can receive CEUs/PDHs even if you attended last year's session.
- The morning session topics qualify for either water, wastewater, or distribution system CEU or PDH credits, however the afternoon session will be broken out into either water or wastewater topics. Please check the correct box on the registration form.
- Attendees may earn 0.6 water or distribution CEUs or 6 hours of PDHs if they attend the morning session and the Water Session in the afternoon. Attendees may only receive 0.6 wastewater license CEUs if they attend the morning session and the Wastewater Session in the afternoon. Please check the correct box on the registration form.
- Those wishing to attend a **second** Focus seminar will receive only 0.3 CEUs toward their *other* (water/wastewater/distribution system) license for the afternoon session, since the morning session will be a duplication in all Focus seminars. *Attending more than two sessions is duplication and CEUs cannot be awarded for duplicate sessions.*
- This training is provided at no charge, however an Administrative/Processing fee (to ensure proper records are kept, tracked, and submitted per DEP requirements) of \$50.00 will be charged to those wishing to earn CEUs and pre-register. Those employed by a current member system will receive a 50% discount (registration will be only \$25.00) if registration is received at least five business days prior to the event. The fee is payable by money order, cashier's check, credit card, or member system company check. (No personal checks or purchase orders will be accepted.)
- Any registration or payment received by FRWA less than five business days prior to the event will be \$75.00. There will be no registration at the door or taken over the telephone.
- If you wish to pay by credit card, you may fax your credit card information to FRWA at 850.893.4581. No registrations will be taken over the telephone.
- There will be no partial CEUs/PDHs for partial attendance of a CEU/PDH session.
- CEUs are not transferable.
- The CEU/PDH form that will be filled out at the session will be a three part carbon form. One copy will be retained by FRWA, one copy will go to the DEP Operator Certification Program, and the attendee will retain one copy for their records.
- Questions related to your records for FRWA sessions should be directed to FRWA, not DEP.
- Due to problems with CEU/PDH forms, CEU/PDH forms must be obtained, completed and submitted at the close of the Session you are attending.
- An attendee that leaves the room while the session is in progress may jeopardize their CEUs for that session.
